Dear Gateway Teams and Families,

The past couple of years have been a crazy ride with gymnastics and the pandemic and we have appreciated your support along the way. In an effort to combat the rising case numbers again, we have decided to, again, keep the spectator limit to 2 spectators per competing gymnast (at their session). We know this is an inconvenience with relatives and siblings who would love to watch, but we are trying our best to accommodate the number of gymnasts, teams, and parents, while still socially distancing everyone. We appreciate everyone planning ahead and only bringing two spectators. We do check all spectators in so please have spectators come in with their competing gymnast. We will also be doing our awards for Championship similarly to last season, so that teams can be spread apart, and parents can remain seated and socially distanced during this time. Please note that masks are still required at all times for spectators and coaches. Gymnasts must be masked when not actively warming up or competing. We have over 400 gymnasts competing in the upcoming Championship meet, so we have tried to reduce session sizes to make it easier to socially distance. Therefore, some sessions are age specific. Please pay close attention when following the schedule, as ages of gymnasts are determined by their age as of Saturday, January 15th, 2022, even if they are competing on Sunday, January 16th.
